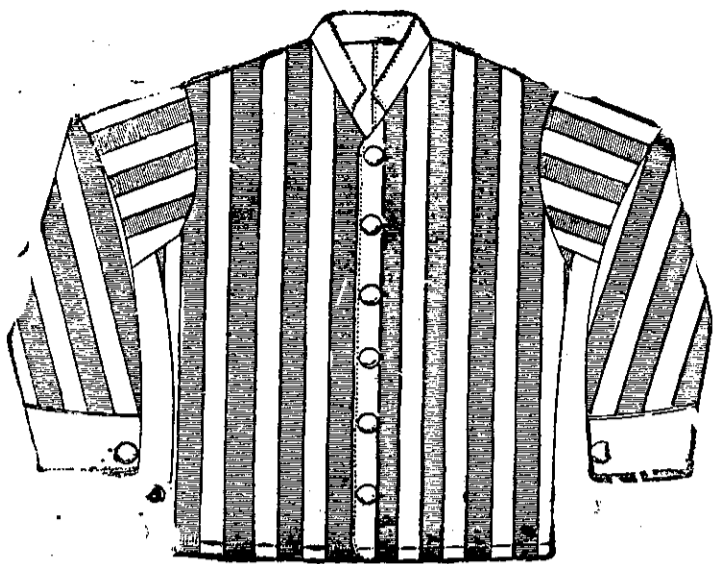

FIRST DAY.

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 26, 1919.

1. MAIDEN PLATE of 100sovs; second horse to receive 20sovs, and third horse 10sovs from the stake. For three-year-olds and upwards that have not won a flat race at time of starting. Weight, 8.0. Entrance 40s. Distance, five furlongs.

2. PRESIDENT'S HANDICAP (Open) of 200sovs; second horse to receive 40sovs, and third horse 20sovs from the stake. Nomination 1sov, acceptance 3sovs. Distance, six furlongs.

3. TAHORAITE HACK WELTER of 125sovs; second horse to receive 25 sovs, and third horse 15sovs from the stake. Minimum weight, 7.7. Nomination 1sov, acceptance 2sovs. Distance, seven furlongs.

4. THE HARTGILL MEMORIAL HANDICAP (Open) of 300sovs; second horse to receive 60sovs, and third horse 30sovs from the stake. Nomination 2sovs, acceptance 4sovs. Distance, one mile and a quarter.

4. NURSERY HANDICAP of 120sovs; second horse to receive 25sovs, and third horse 10sovs from the stake. For two-year-olds. Nomination 1 sov, acceptance 2sovs. Distance, five furlongs.

5. AUTUMN HANDICAP (Open) of 200 sovs; second horse to receive 40 sovs, and third horse 20sovs from the stake. Nomination 1sov, acceptance 3sovs. Distance, one mile and a furlong.

6. TELEPHONE HACK HANDICAP of 110sovs; second horse to receive 20sovs, and third horse 10sovs from the stake. Nomination 1sov, acceptance 2sovs. Distance, six furlongs.

7. KAITOKI WELTER (Open) of 150 sovs; second horse to receive 30 sovs, and third horse 15sovs from the stake. Nomination 1sov, acceptance 50s. Distance, seven furlongs.

8. TAPUATA HACK WELTER of 125 sovs; second horse to receive 25 sovs, and third horse 15sovs from the stake. Nomination 1sov, acceptance 2sovs. Distance, one mile and 50 yards.

**PENALTIES.**

The winner of any flat race after declaration of weights if handicapped under 8.10 to carry 10lb penalty, and for every additional win 6lb extra. If handicapped at 8.10 or over to carry only half the above penalty.
