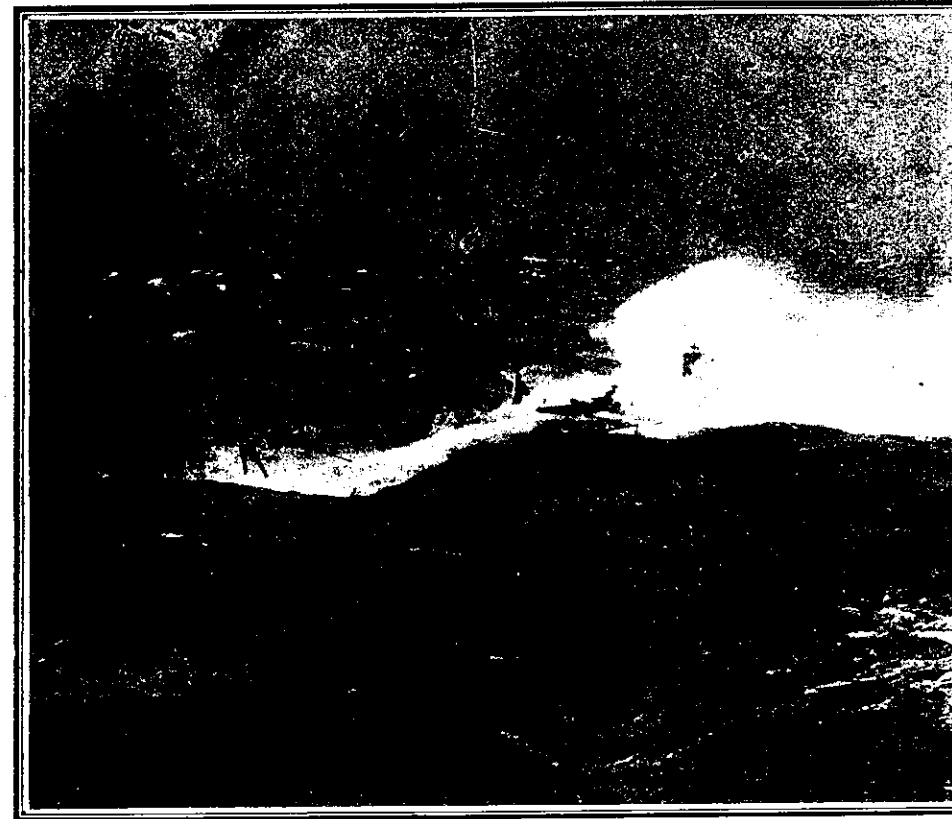


Active Participants in the Great War, and the Revival of Sport in England
