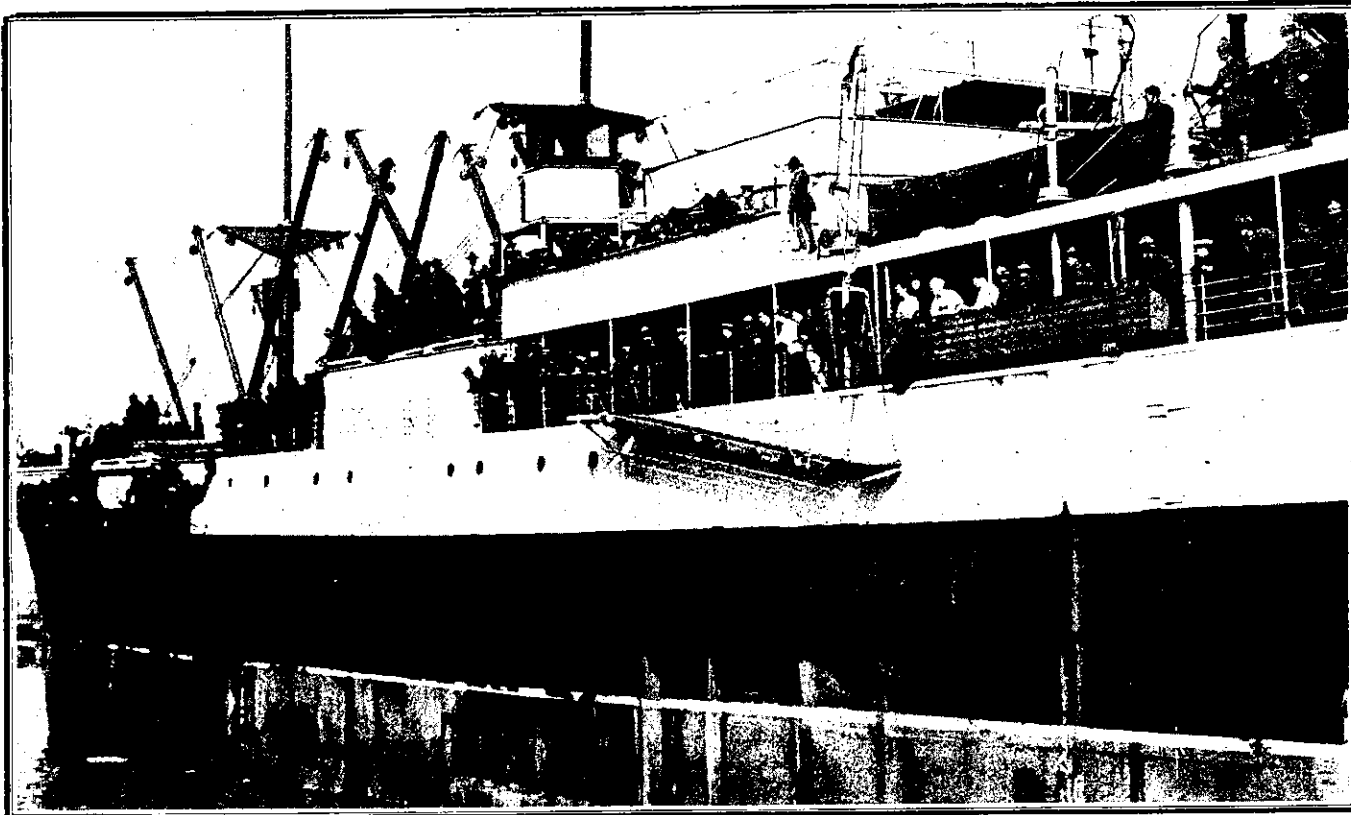
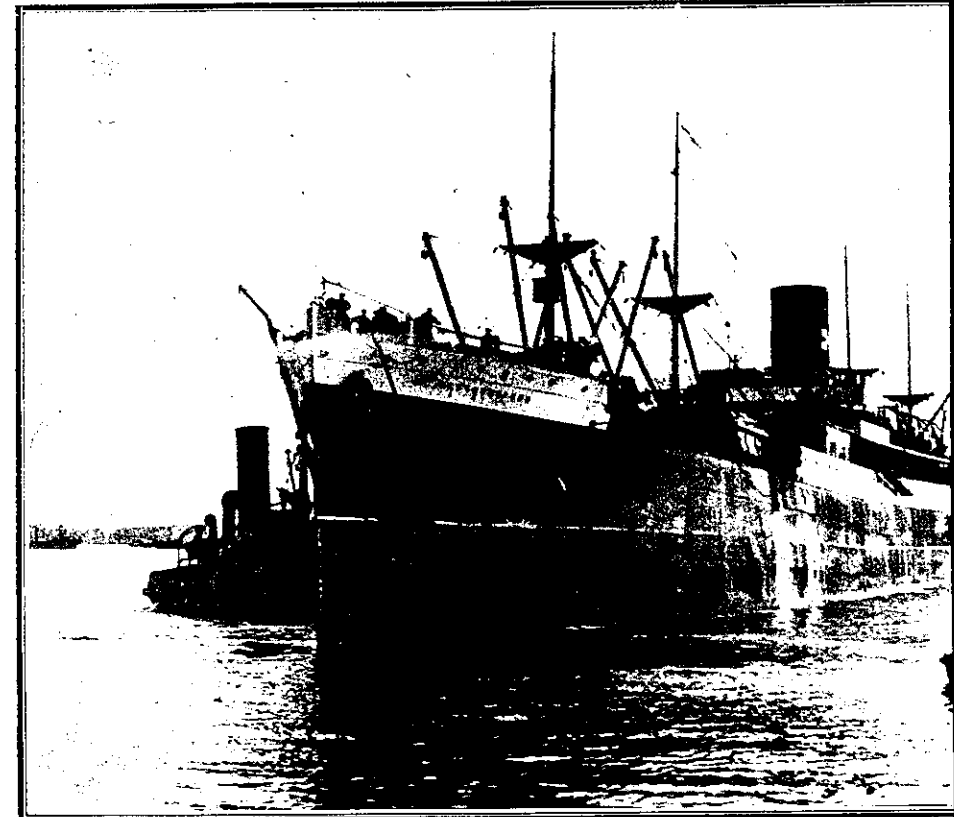


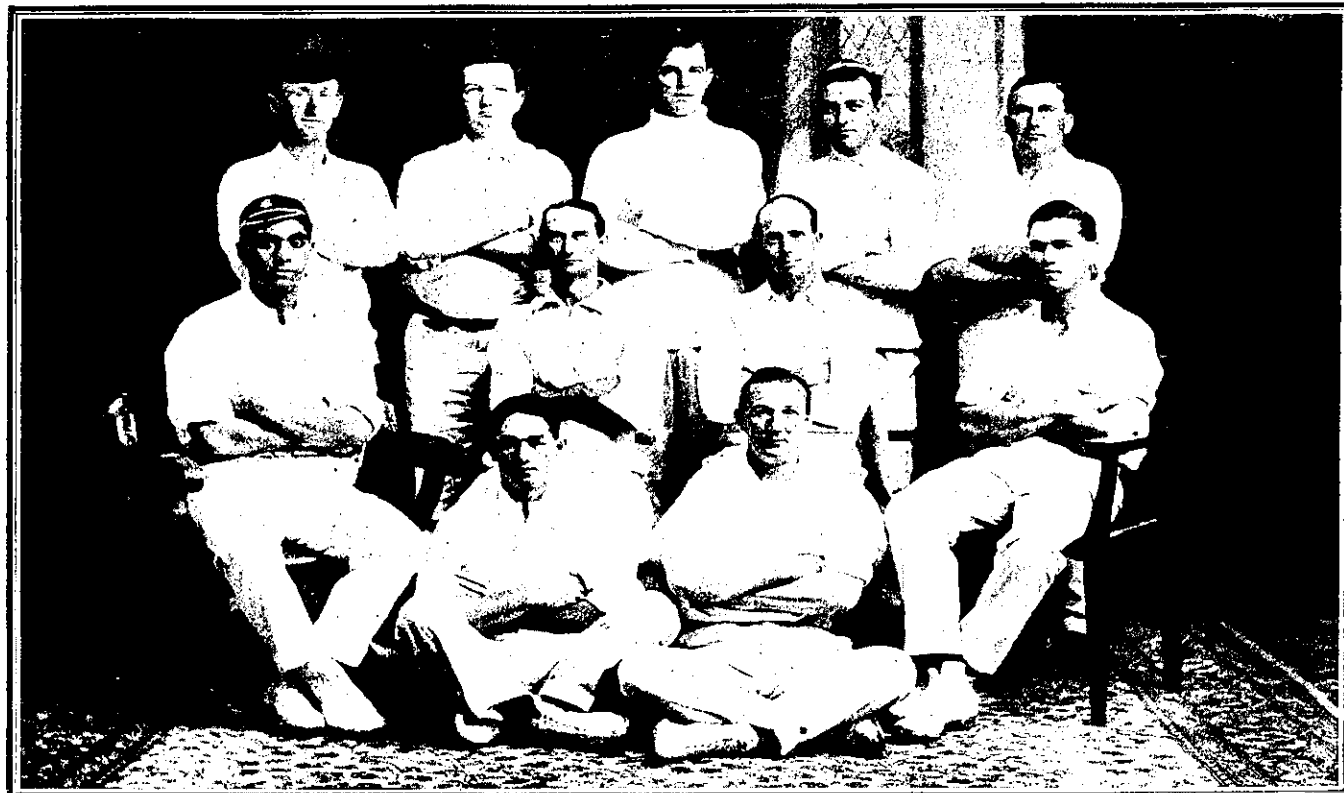
Return to Auckland of the Maori Soldiers, and Two Interesting Groups of Keen Cricketing Enthusi
