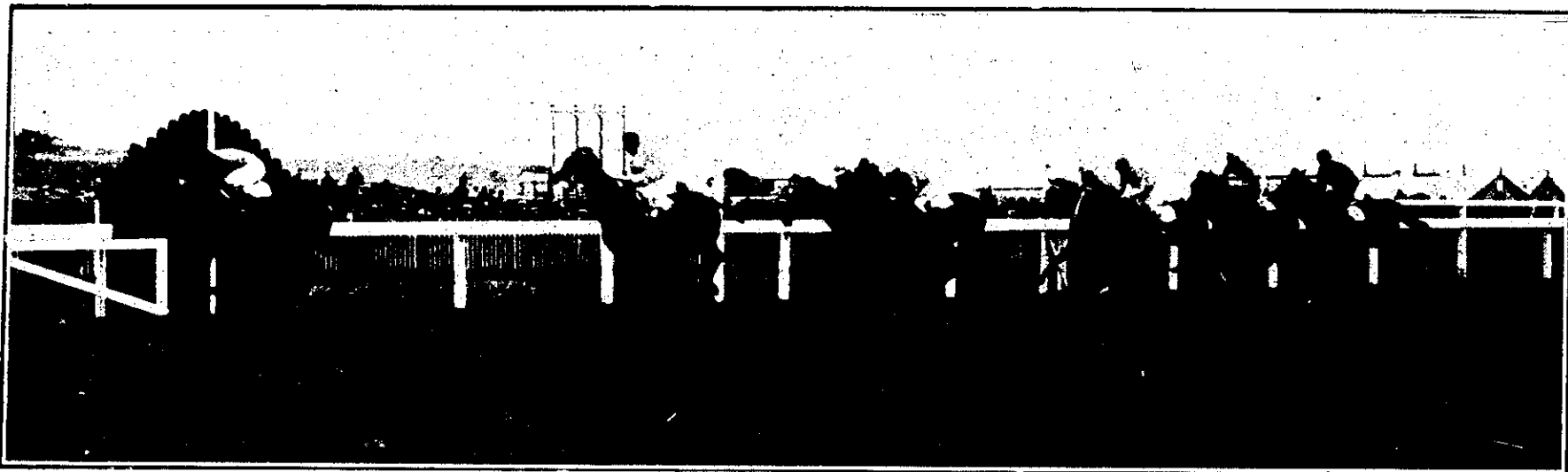
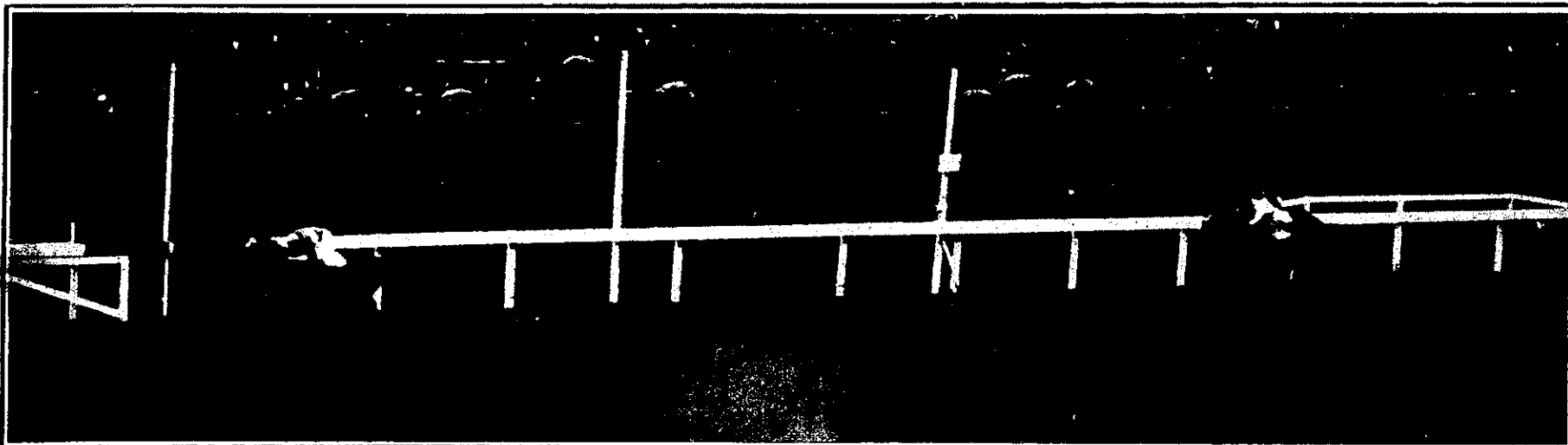


Resumption of Racing in New South Wales---The Australian J. C.'s Autumn Meeting at Randwick.



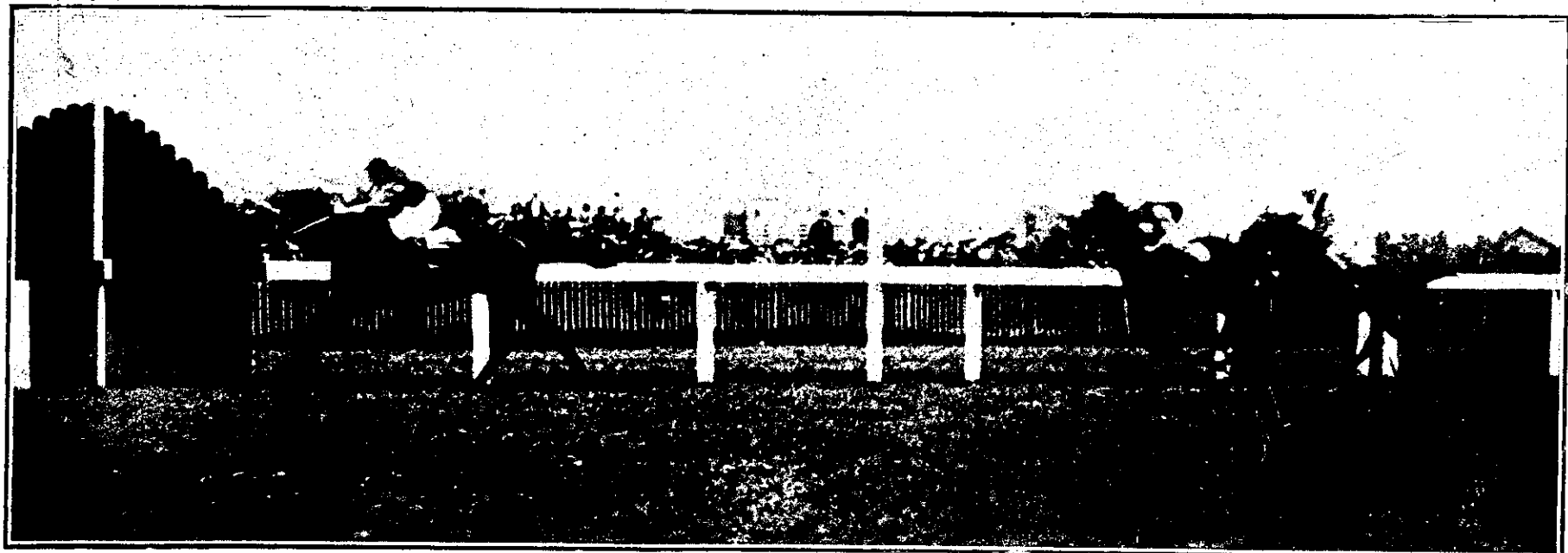
