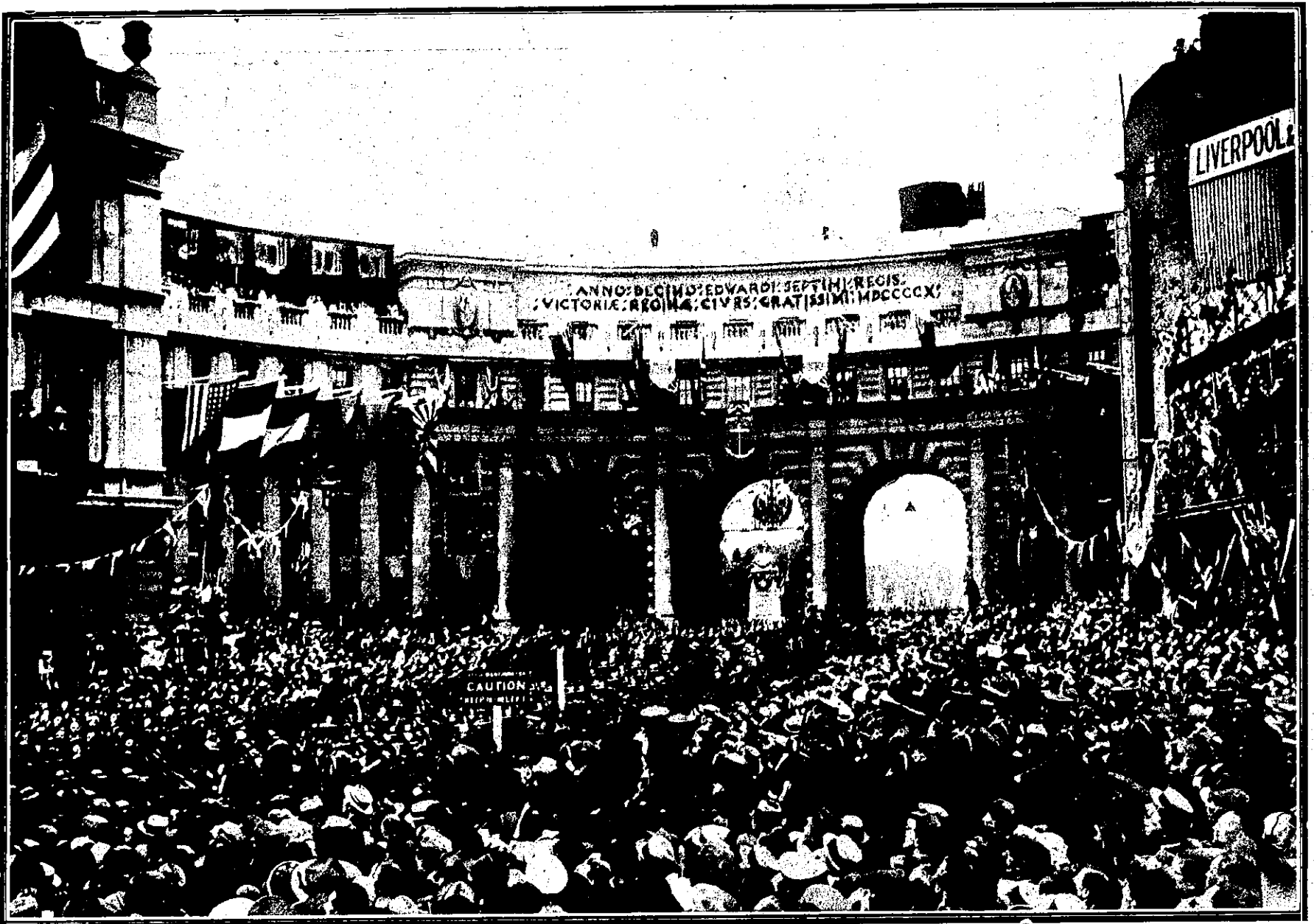
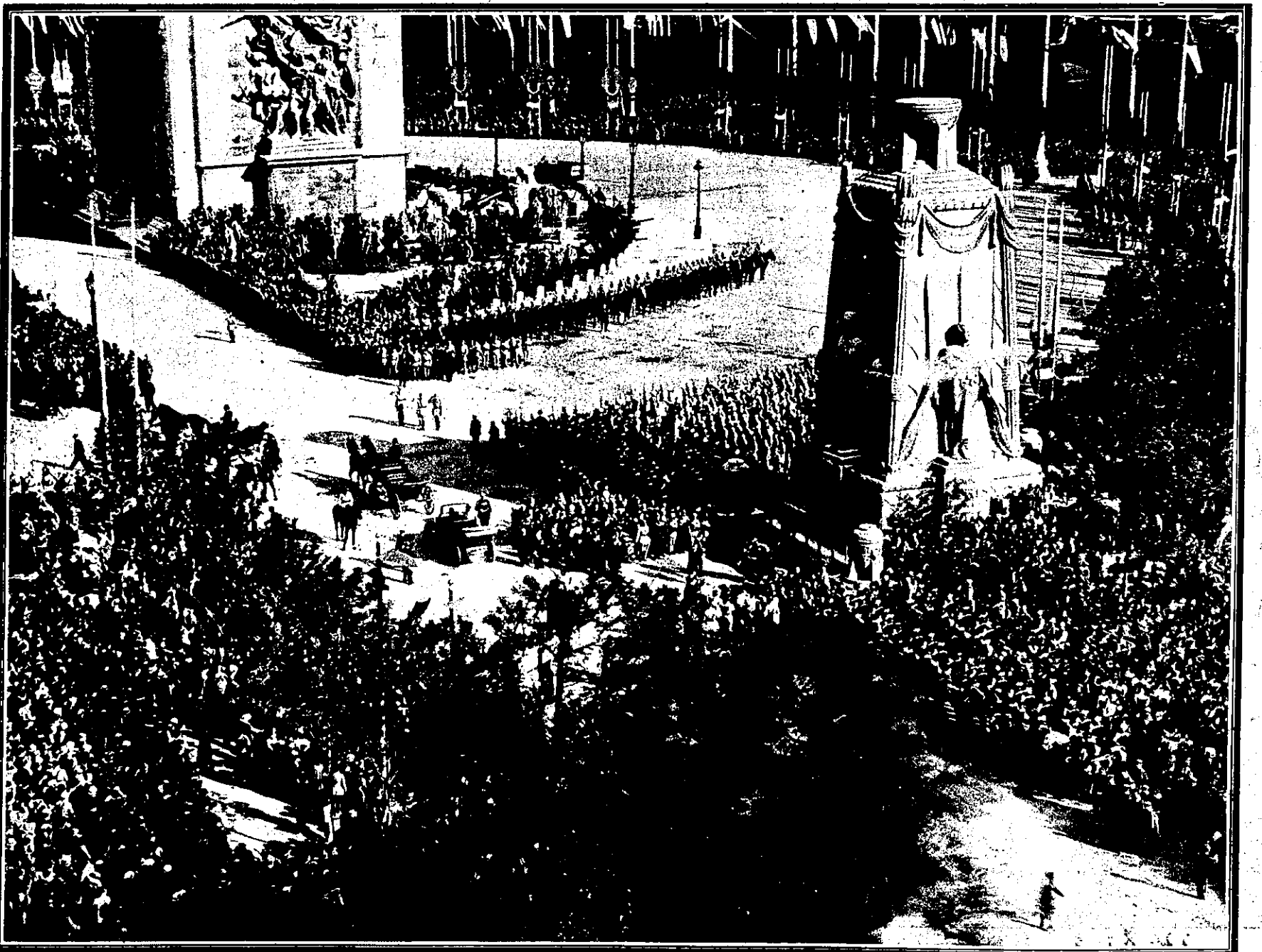


Animated Scenes in London and Paris during the Victory Celebrations.
