Genial warm weather was experienced for the concluding day of the Dannevirke Racing Club's autumn meeting. Consequently there was a large attendance, the fair sex assembling in goodly numbers. The club's patrons were rewarded with some very interesting racing, the finishes in several of the events

being of a very close character. The club tried a ten-shilling totalisator, but owing to the inadequate arrangements and the crush that was caused the innovation was discarded on the second day, and only one pound tickets were issued. Speculation was again brisk, the sum of £9599 being handled, compared with £5893 on the corresponding day last year, making an aggregate for the meeting of £19,289, against £11,941, an increase of £7348.
