ST. AMANS WINS THE CUP.

The weather for the opening day of the South Auckland Racing Club's autumn meeting was showery, but the attendance was good, and some excellent racing was witnessed.

The officials of the club could also afford to regard pressmen as worthy of consideration, if not courtesy. Mr. Robert Wynyard (handicapper) was particularly successful with most of his adjustments.

Taketumu led all the way till the straight was reached, when St. Amans and Sir Artegal shot ahead and fought out conclusions. St. Amans won a good race by a length and a-half, while Waiohahi, who came fast was only a neck behind Sir Artegal. Time, 2min 11 2-5sec.
