The programme to be decided on the occasion of the New Zealand championships is as follows:-

Maiden Fours. One mile .-- First prize, £9; second, £2. To start at 11.30 a.m.

Champion Sculls. One mile and a half.—First, £8; second, £2. Noon. Junior Fours. One mile and a half .--First, £12; second, £3. 12.30 p.m. Champion Fours. Two miles. - First, £30; second, £10 1.30 p.m.

Maiden Double Sculls. One mile .-First, £5; second, £1. 2 p.m. Youths' Fours. One mile.—First, £8;

second, £2. 2.30 p.m. Champion Double Sculls. One mile

and a half.—First, £12; second, £3. 2.45 p.m.

One mile.---First, Junior Fours. £10; second, £2 3.30 p.m.

Champion Pairs. One mile and a half. -First, £12; second, £3. 4 p.m.

Maiden Pairs. One mile.—First, £5, second, £1. 4.30 p.m. Senior Fours. One mile and a half.



Mr J. Booth, who recently carried off the two and five miles Australasian Motor Cycle Championship, held in Melbourne, made a successful attempt recently on the one-hour Australasian motor cycle track record. The ride was accomplished on the Melbourne Sports Grounds, three laps to a mile, and although the track conditions militated against exceptionally fast speed, Booth succeeded in covering 155 laps in 60 minutes, or three laps better than the previous figures, which stood to the credit of another Victorian motor cyclist-J. The total mileage was 52 Luckey. miles 201 yards.
