The amount won by any horse in flat races, hurdle races, or steeplechases respectively, shall be estimated separately, and shall not debar such horse from entry except in the special class of race in which he has won the amounts.

PENALTIES.

The winner of any flat race after the declaration of weights to carry 7lb. penalty, and every additional race 7lb. extra, except Maiden Race, additional penalty in this case is 5lb.
