

The success registered by the ex-Aucklander All Talk in the Spye Welter Handicap at the Brackenfield Hunt meeting was overdue, and marked the son of All Black's first win during his extended stay in the South Island. He was ridden a well-judged race in the event named by Young, who got him home a head in advance of Nautical after a desperate finish. Since being purchased by the Gisborne sportsman, Mr. F. J. Lysnar, early in the New Year from Mr. J. Regan, of Auckland, All Talk won a hack hurdle race at Napier Park, and a welter handicap at Dannevirke, but was a long way further down on the list of winning horses for the season just closed than dur-ing the 1918-19 term, when he won £1055 in stakes.


