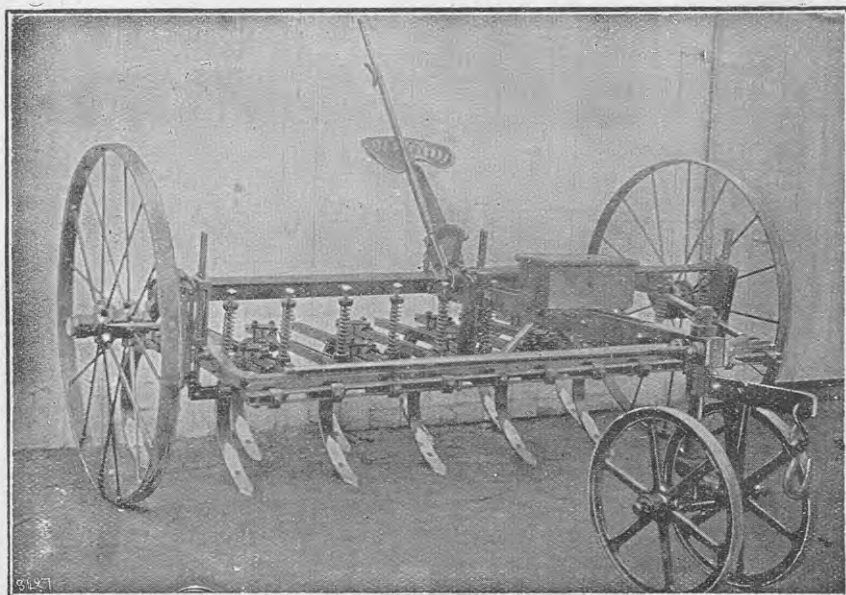


"The writer is quite convinced that for the eradication of weeds we use the disk harrow too much and the cultivator too little.
