

## Y.F.C. Football Match at Manawatu Show



A RUGBY football match between a team representing the Wairoa Young Farmers' Club and a team picked from the clubs in the Manawatu district was played at the Manawatu Winter Show, Palmerston North, on Thursday, 15th June.
