Note the stronger growth with more clover. Fig. 3—Super alone on sandy soil. Only slight response. Fig. 4—Super + potash + lime on sandy soil. Pasture much improved. Fig. 5—Super alone on peat soil. Pasture lacks vigour. Potash or lime alone give similar results. Fig. 6—Super + lime + potash on peat soil. Note the much improved condition of the sward.
