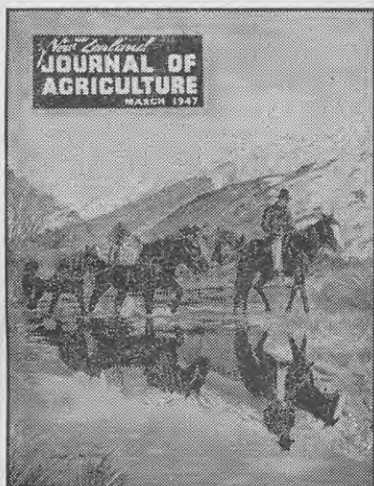


## This month's cover
