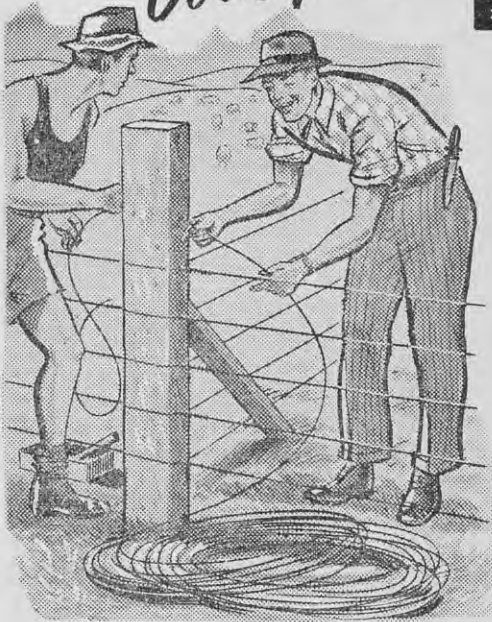
Tips for Farmers

1. When erecting fences or making sub-divisions, examine the wire for damage to the spelter coating from chemical attack between the factory and farm or the removal of zinc by abrasion.
2. See that the jaws of your strainer are not nicking too deeply.
3. Make sure that you are not over-straining the wire. Don't strain an 8-gauge wire beyond 600 lbs.

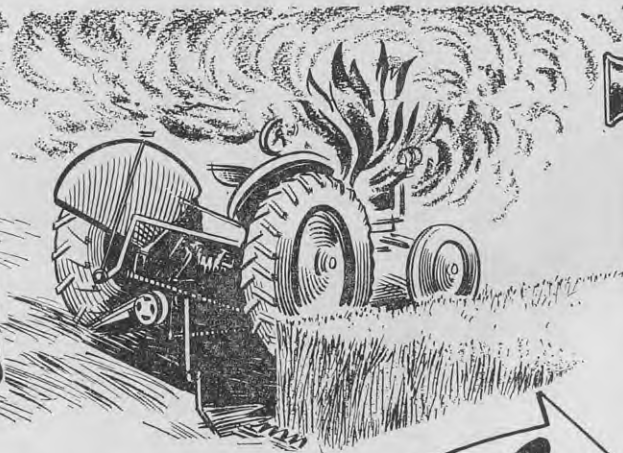
