COUNTY OF MANUKAU.

Maungatawhiri Licensing District.—Comprises all that area known as the Road Districts of Pukekohe East and Maungatawhiri, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 42, of the 18th May, 1883.

Given under the hand of His Excellency Sir William Francis Drummond Jervois, Lieutenant-General in Her Majesty's Army, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same; and issued under the Seal of the said Colony, at the Government House, at Wellington, this twenty-first day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four.

Season for Shooting Native Game, Wanganui.

IN exercise of the powers vested in me by "The Animals Protection Act, 1880," and "The Animals Protection Act Amendment Act, 1881," I, William Francis Drummond Jervois, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby declare that native game (excepting tuis) may be taken or killed within the Wanganui District, consisting of the Counties of Wanganui and Rangitikei, from the first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four, to the thirty-first day of July, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four, both inclusive.

As witness the hand of His Excellency the Governor, this twenty-eighth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four.
