

PALMERSTON NORTH.—10th ultimo, on **warrant** for being in possession of a mould for making counterfeit coin, **Mick Bitossi**, age about twenty-four, height 5 ft. 4 in. or 5 in., plaster-mould maker and labourer (hawks statutory), native of Italy, dark complexion, long black hair, black eyes, clean-shaved, active build; wears dark suit and cap.
