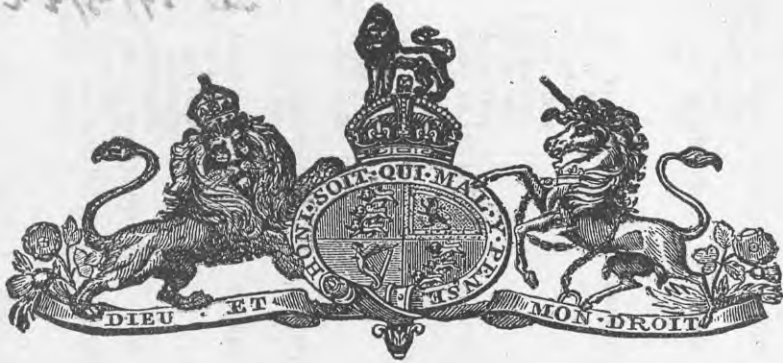

## PERSONS WANTED.

AUCKLAND.—23rd June last, on warrant for theft of a watch (recovered) and other articles described in *Police Gazette*, 1921, page 527, **William Barnett**, alias **Barrett**, age thirty-two, height 5 ft. 6 in., labourer, native of New Zealand, strong build, fresh complexion, brown hair, blue eyes, clean-shaved, shield and flags on left forearm, scar near left side of nose; dressed in grey worsted trousers, dark-grey-tweed coat, and cap.
