AUCKLAND.—Inquiries are to be made to establish the identity of a **Man** whose dead body was found in a bedroom at the Strand Hotel, Parnell, on the 25th July last. Description: Age about forty-nine, height 5 ft. 9½ in., bushman, dark swarthy complexion, dark hair turning grey, blue-grey eyes, clean-shaved, scar under left knee-cap, small scar inside of right knee, thin scar on left forearm, scar on right knuckles of ring and little fingers, indistinct scar on left cheek, small hook near top of nose, good teeth. At an inquest held on the 7th instant the Coroner returned a verdict of suicide by poison. The deceased was known to the licensee of the Waiwera Hotel as **James Samuel Smith**, and an envelope was also found in his property addressed **J. S. Smith**, Waiwera. Photographs of deceased appear above. If any information is obtained, a communication is to be sent to the Inspector of Police, Auckland.

Memorandum.]

Opossum Regulations.

With reference to memorandum of 19th May, 1921, published in Police Gazette, 1921, page 342, the Internal Affairs Department advises that, as the above regulations have now been in force for some time and persons have had a reasonable opportunity of becoming aware of the provisions, it is not considered necessary that papers in connection with alleged

breaches of the regulations should be referred to that Department in future before proceedings are taken. Prosecutions may therefore be instituted by officers in charge of district without reference to this office.

As the regulations provide that all forfeited skins shall become the property of the Crown, such skins should be sold by auction through a licensed broker appointed for the purposes of the regulations, and the proceeds of the sale paid into the Public Account, and bank receipt forwarded to the Under-Secretary, Department of Internal Affairs.
