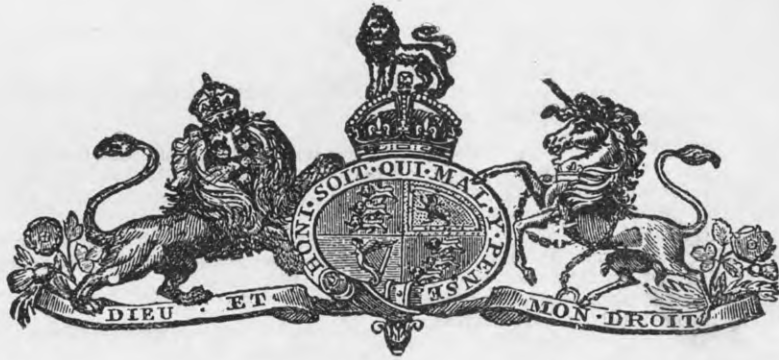

### Murder.

KUROW.—22nd instant on warrant for the murder of Olive Jean Rutherford, Caversham, Dunedin, **Philip Richard Hudson**, age nineteen, height 5 ft. 6 in., student, native of New Zealand, slight build, sallow complexion, dark short hair, brown eyes, dressed in a brownish-grey suit and black shoes. At about 7.30 a.m. on above date accused was seen sitting in his motor-car on the roadside near Omarama. Shortly afterwards the car and deceased were found in the bed of the Waitaki River, having fallen over a cliff. A discharged rifle cartridge was found near deceased and another near the motor-car. Medical examination revealed a rifle-bullet in deceased's brain.
