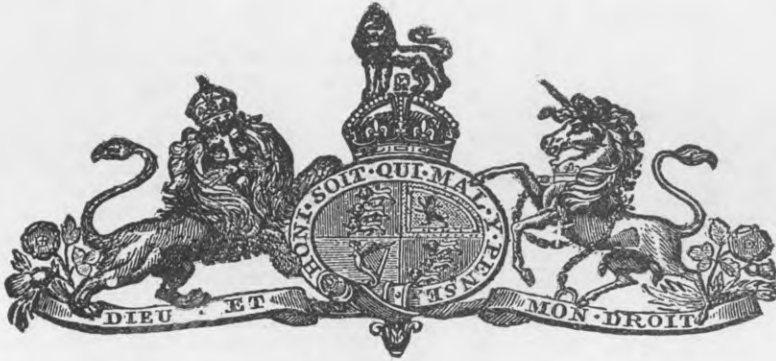

Opossum Regulations.

The following copy of a circular issued by the Under-Secretary, Department of Internal Affairs, to all brokers licensed under the Opossum Regulations is published for the information of members of the Force.

Circular letter No. 455.]

Department of Internal Affairs,
Wellington, 23rd June, 1925.

SIR,—I have the honour, by direction of the Minister of Internal Affairs, to call your attention to Regulation No. 9 of the regulations of 13th May, 1924, respecting opossums, which provides that no person shall act as a broker without a license, and that a separate license must be taken out in respect of any branch of the business.

In connection with the matter, information has been received that in some cases persons not being recognized employees of a firm of brokers are acting as buying and collecting agents for brokers without themselves being the holder of a broker's license.

There is an objection to a person acting as a collecting agent without taking out a broker's license if his work amounts to the conduct of a business or branch business. The terms on which he receives the skins, whether as a broker strictly so called, or as a purchaser, and whether as a purchaser with his own money or with that of somebody else, are immaterial.

A person who is not a recognized member of a firm of brokers must have a license if he purchases unstamped

opossum-skins, and (a) his work amounts to carrying on a business or a branch of a business; (b) the firm itself does not hold a license in respect of the business of the branch.

It is not essential that a person purchasing skins who is a recognized employee of a firm of licensed brokers must himself have a license, provided that a license is in existence for the business or branch of a business in which he is engaged.

It must be borne in mind, however, that if such employee is definitely stationed away from the place of business of the employer this constitutes a branch of the business, and a separate license must be procured for such branch.

You will see from the above that no person may purchase unstamped opossum-skins unless he is a licensed broker or one of the partners in a firm of licensed brokers, or unless he is a recognized employee of a firm of licensed brokers; and I should therefore be glad if you would take the necessary action to have applications made by any person who is acting on behalf of your firm for the issue of a broker's license, on receipt of which the question of issuing a license will receive immediate consideration.

In the meantime, it is desirable that you inform any agents with whom you may have relations not to proceed with the obtaining or purchasing of skins unless and until they obtain a broker's license.
