SPECIAL NOTICE.

Murder.

CHRISTCHURCH.—At 2 p.m. on the 15th instant the dead body of Ellen Gwendoline Isobel Scarff was found in an unfenced section off Lake Terrace Road, Burwood. Deceased was four months pregnant, and medical evidence proved that death had taken place within three hours previous to the discovery of the body. Extensive wounds on the head indicated that a blunt instrument had been used to beat her to death. A blood-stained double spanner about 10 in. long, with serrated jaws, was found in the gorse adjacent to the spot where the body was discovered. Deceased was seen in Cathedral Square at about 6.15 o'clock on the evening

preceding the discovery of her body, but her subsequent movements cannot be ascertained. Any information regarding the murder is to be communicated to the Superintendent of Police, Christchurch.
