

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION.

Unemployment Act, 1930.—Form U.B. 16 (Application for Exemption from Payment of Unemployment Levy on grounds of Hardship).

Attention is directed to the form of certificate in U.B. 16 whereby the person signing the certificate below the signature of the applicant certifies that to the best of his knowledge and belief the applicant's declaration is a true and correct statement.

Before any member of the Police Force signs such a certificate, he should from his own knowledge or from facts ascertained by him be in a position to support his certificate if called upon to do so.

The certificate referred to goes much further than simply witnessing the applicant's signature.
