

WELLINGTON.—11th instant, for escaping from custody, **Lillian Anderson**, alias **Patricia Maloney**, age twenty, height 5 ft. 2 in., domestic, native of England, thin build, fresh complexion, dark-brown hair, hazel eyes; wearing a black and grey coat, with heavy fur collar. At Wellington, on the 25th June last, she was sentenced to three years in a Borstal Institution, and whilst at the hospital awaiting treatment for venereal disease she escaped. *arrested 23/12/31.*

WELLINGTON.—12th ultimo, on warrant of commitment to Wellington Prison for forty-eight hours in default of paying £1 5s. fine and costs for distributing handbills, **James Forbes**, age thirty-two, fireman, native of Scotland.
