PERSONS WANTED.

AUCKLAND.—11th June last, on **warrant** for theft of £10 the property of Harvie Oil Turbine Motor Co., Ltd., engineers, Keane's Buildings, **Samuel Francis Dickey**, referred to in Police Gazette, 1932, page 233.
