Manslaughter.

DUNEDIN.—At 11.45 p.m. on the 27th ultimo, George Macandrew Frost, a railway guard, whilst cycling in Anderson's Bay Road, was struck and killed by a Buick sedan motor-car. The car did not stop, and the driver appeared to accelerate; glass from the wind-screen and head-lamps and a parking-light were found at the scene of the fatality. At 8 a.m. on the following day the motor-car was found abandoned at Eglinton Road. It was later ascertained that the car had been stolen from Stafford Street, between 9.30 p.m. and the time the fatality occurred. Any information which may lead to the identity of the offender is to be communicated to the Superintendent of Police, Dunedin.

Further to my memorandum of the 9th April, a copy of which you advised was published in the Police Gazette, it now appears that the requirements of this Office expressed therein are not being observed in many cases. To enable vouchers to be prepared in accordance with the provisions of the legislation governing wages-tax and salary cuts, it is necessary for sub-enumerators, on completing the work in their respective districts, to furnish the following particulars to the Census and Statistics Office:—

- (1) Actual (or approximate) number of holdings, if any, for which returns were received during the month of April.
- (2) Actual (or approximate) number of holdings, if any, for which returns were received on or after the 1st May.

I shall be glad if you will kindly arrange to notify these requirements to Police officers engaged in the collection of agricultural and pastoral statistics through the medium of the Police Gazette.
