Erratum.

Disqualification under Motor-vehicles Act removed.

The disqualification from obtaining a motor-driver's license imposed upon **Thomas Alexander Landreth**, referred to in Police Gazette, 1932, page 253, has been removed as from the 7th October, 1932. A prohibition order has been issued against him.

WHANGAREI.—4th instant, on **warrant** of commitment to Auckland Prison for two months in default of paying £15 19s. fine and costs for a breach of the Law Practitioners Act, **Harold Bradley Brownrigg**, age about forty-six, height 5 ft. 9 in., salesman and accountant, native of New Zealand, medium build, fresh complexion, light-brown hair turning grey; usually wears a brown suit and bowler hat; smart appearance. *Paid 29/10/32*

AUCKLAND.—On or about the 4th ultimo, on **warrant** for theft of £70, the property of Herbert Henson, **Al. Cooper**, age about forty-three, height 5 ft. 5 in., strong build, mottled complexion, hair turning grey, dark heavy bushy eyebrows; dressed in a navy-blue or dark-grey suit and grey felt hat. Complainant gave to accused £70 to invest in exchange speculations. The latter has disappeared, and may be accompanied by his wife, age about thirty, height about 5 ft. 4 in., thin build, fair complexion, wide mouth, full lips. They have with them a black Pomeranian bitch which answers to the name "Mitzi." Accused may endeavour to leave this Dominion.
