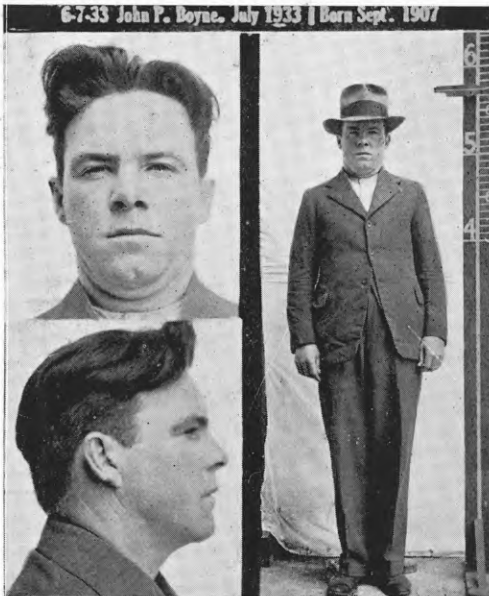


SUPPLEMENT TO THE NEW ZEALAND POLICE GAZETTE.

WELLINGTON, WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 5, 1934.

This supplement contains the photographs, and in most cases the descriptions, of Australian criminals who are considered likely to come to New Zealand during the tour of H.R.H. the Duke of Gloucester. If it is ascertained that any of these persons have departed for this Dominion, or have arrived here, the following provisions of the Immigration Laws are to be considered and appropriate action taken: Sec. 14 (d), Immigration Restriction Act, 1908; Sec. 3, Immigration Restriction Amendment Act, 1923; Sec. 4, Immigration Restriction Amendment Act, 1931; Sec. 2, Immigration Restriction Amendment Act, 1933; and Secs. 5 and 11, Undesirable Immigrants Exclusion Act, 1919.
