PERSONS WANTED

AUCKLAND.—16th ultimo, on **warrant** of commitment to Auckland Prison for three months in default of paying £24 arrears on a maintenance order for the support of his wife, Martha Mabel Leeder, **Arnold Clanda Leeder**, age about forty-eight, height 6 ft., motor-car dealer, medium build, sallow complexion, curly dark hair, grey eyes, stutters slightly; dressed in a brownish heather mixture suit (seldom wears a hat.

AUCKLAND.—On or about the 13th July, 1936, on **warrant** for theft of £39, the property of the New Zealand Institute for the Blind, Parnell Road, **George Edward Bridgens**, age about twenty-three, height about 5 ft. 11 in., clerk, native of New Zealand, medium build, sallow complexion, dark hair, blue eyes, black eyebrows inclined to be bushy, dimple in chin; always well dressed. Accused was employed as a clerk in the New Zealand Institute for the Blind when he stole sums of money totalling £285 2s. 2d. He left his employment on the 24th July, 1936, and went to Australia.

WELLINGTON.—27th ultimo, on **warrant** for failing to comply with the terms of a maintenance order for the support of his wife, Ellen Mary Amundsen, 58 Taranaki Street, **Gordon Thomas Amundsen**, age thirty-four, height 5 ft. 6 in., plumber and motor-driver, native of New Zealand, fresh complexion, brown hair going bald, blue eyes, scars on left upper arm, on right knee, and on abdomen, wart under right eye; ruptured. ASHBURTON.—22nd September last, on **warrant** for theft of a watch (recovered), value, £1 10s., the property of Keith Edgar Newton, **Bert Collett**, age about forty-five, height 5 ft. 7 in., cook, native of New Zealand, slight build, ruddy complexion, ginger hair, large nose, large scar on one forearm; walks with a slight stoop; usually dressed in a brown suit and grey cap; squints when talking. Accused was employed as a cook at a sawmill at Newlands, and while there he stole the watch. It was sold on the 22nd September to a second-hand dealer in Christchurch for 6s. by a man who gave the name **Albert Collett**. He is also suspected of having committed other offences. *arrested 13/1/37.*
