WELLINGTON.—The above is a photograph of **Stanley Charles Maisey**, who is wanted for attempted murder, referred to in Police Gazette, 1936, page 175. It has been ascertained that the accused, who has now grown a moustache, assumed the name **Charles Martin**, and was employed by J. H. Lane, contractor, Putaruru, for about ten months prior to 22nd February last, when he left without giving notice and without drawing his wages, amounting to about £30. He was employed fencing at Putaruru, and lived alone in a tent. He will probably endeavour to obtain employment in the country under similar circumstances.

AUCKLAND.—8th instant, the dead body of a recently born child of apparently seven months gestation, was found in Grafton Gully, under Grafton Bridge. The body was wrapped in portions of copies of the "Auckland Star," dated 17th March, 1937, 24th March, 1937, and 31st March, 1937, and around the outside of these wrappings was a brown paper bag, which appeared to have been used as a woman's hat-bag. The body is that of a female European child, and had not breathed. There was a fracture on the skull, which had occurred after death, apparently caused when the body was thrown from Grafton Bridge into the Grafton Gully. Any information which would assist in establishing the parentage of the child is to be communicated to the Superintendent of Police, Auckland.

HASTINGS.—About 6.30 a.m. on 7th instant, the body of Frank Wild, shepherd, of Pakipaki, near Hastings, was found on the side of the Main Highway, about 3½ miles south of Hastings. The left boot had been wrenched off the foot and the boot was found on the railway track, some distance away from the body, suggesting that it had been picked up by some person and thrown from the roadway across to the railway track. A post-mortem examination showed that there was an injury at the back of both legs, behind the knees. There was a complete dislocation of the neck, which severed the spinal cord. There was deep concussion of the brain, but no fracture of the skull, and there were abrasions on the right side of the head. The injuries are consistent with deceased having been struck from behind by a motor-vehicle. It is presumed that the front bumper of the vehicle hit him at the back of the knees, throwing him back, his neck being dislocated when his head struck the ground. Wild is believed to have left Hastings, walking south, about 6 p.m. on the 6th instant, and the accident may have occurred about one hour and a half later. Inquiries are to be made for any motor-vehicle which may have been recently damaged or any other information which may lead to the discovery of the person responsible for the accident. Any information should be immediately communicated to the Inspector of Police, Napier.

Form 60 is to be made out in duplicate. The original must be forwarded promptly to the Probation Officer and the duplicate is to be affixed to the file immediately under Form 59.

The information contained in Form 60 must relate only to facts which can, if necessary, be proved, as under the Offenders' Probation Act, 1920, Section 6, a prisoner has the right to see the Probation Officer's report, and to tender evidence on any matter referred to therein.

When a prisoner committed for trial or sentence has previous convictions, such convictions must be shown on Form 99. If the prisoner has not been convicted previously, his name and description are to be shown on the space provided for that purpose and the form endorsed "No previous convictions." This form is to be made out in triplicate. One copy must be sent to the Probation Officer with Form 60, one copy to the Gaoler, and the third affixed to the file immediately under Form 60.

If a prisoner committed for trial or sentence has been admitted to bail, Form Police 82 must be filled in and forwarded to the Superintendent of the Prison to which the accused would have been committed had he not been admitted to bail. A copy of this form must also be attached to the file.

Where there is any information that the police desire to place before the Court or which the Court is likely to require, such information must be conveyed in writing through the Crown Solicitor. The use of Form 60A and old Forms 59, 60, and 82 is to be discontinued.

Motor Registration : Relicensing of Vehicles for Year ending 31st May, 1938.

The following copy of a memorandum received from the Registrar of Motor-vehicles is published for general information. It is desired that proceedings be taken against persons observed to be using motor-vehicles on and after 1st June next with the old number-plates (black numerals on golden yellow ground) attached, but in cases where a motorist, having purchased new registration-plates, has a valid reason for not having them affixed on the 1st June to the motor-vehicle to which they belong, discretion should be exercised as to whether a prosecution should necessarily

follow, as each case should be judged on its merits. When it is desired to ascertain from the Motor-registration Office the name and address of the owner of a motor-vehicle bearing the old number-plates, application should be made by memorandum from the Officer in Charge of the District to the Registrar of Motor-vehicles, Wellington.

RELICENSING OF MOTOR-VEHICLES FOR YEAR ENDING
31ST MAY, 1938.

Although the relicensing for the year 1937-38 is being commenced on the 1st proximo, owners of motor-vehicles may not under the extant legislation legally affix the new plates to their vehicles before the 1st June next.

The colour combination of the number-plates for the ensuing licensing year is white numerals and border-line on a black ground. The symbol is in the form of a small key-hole. There will not be any departure from the lettering appearing on this year's number-plates, but only one plate will be assigned to trailers for the year 1937-38, irrespective of whether either "R" or "E" numbers are assigned to them.

It would be appreciated if you would kindly consider the question of instructing your officers to take action against persons using unlicensed vehicles after the 31st proximo. As there is no insurance cover in terms of the Motor-vehicles Insurance (Third-party Risks) Act, 1928, in respect of unlicensed vehicles it is important that owners of motor-vehicles should not use them before paying the prescribed amounts of annual license fee and insurance premium.
