**THE TRAFFIC SIGN (SPEED-LIMITS) REGULATIONS, 1936.**

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.  
Act pursuant to which the regulations were made : The Motor-vehicles Act, 1924.

Date on which the regulations were made : 16th day of December, 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette* : 17th day of December, 1936.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Traffic Sign (Speed-limits) Regulations, 1936.
2. These regulations shall come into force on the 21st day of December, 1936.
3. In these regulations, unless inconsistent with the context,—
  - “The said Act” means the Motor-vehicles Amendment Act, 1936 :
  - “Closely populated locality” means a locality declared to be a closely populated locality for the purposes of section 3 of the said Act :
  - “Erecting authority” means in respect of any road or place the local authority as hereinafter defined, and also includes the Minister and the Main Highways Board :
  - “Local authority” means in respect of any road or place the local authority in the district of which the road or place is situated :
  - “Local speed-limit” means a speed-limit for motor-vehicle traffic duly imposed by a local authority :
  - “Minister” means the Minister of Transport :
  - “Road” includes road, street, or other place to which the public have access, and includes any portion of a road (as herein defined) that is physically continuous with any other portion of road, whether bearing a separate name or not, if one of such portions is and the other is not subject to any speed-limit or exclusion from a speed-limit to which these regulations relate :
  - “Traffic sign” means a sign as described in these regulations.
