## PERSONS WANTED

QUEEN STREET WHARF (AUCKLAND).—12th ultimo, on warrant for deserting from s.s. "Waimana," **William Couper**, age twenty, steward, native of England, fair complexion and hair, blue eyes. *arrested 9-6-37*

AUCKLAND.—9th ultimo, on warrant of commitment to Auckland Prison for two months in default of paying £36 17s. 6d. arrears on a maintenance order for the support of his child, **Keven Francis Burns**, age thirty-three, height 5 ft. 10 in., labourer, native of New Zealand, medium build, fresh complexion, brown hair, grey eyes, mole on right shoulder, scar on right thigh. AUCKLAND.—25th September last, for unlawfully converting to his own use a motor-car (recovered), value, £165, the property of Cyril Urquhart, garage proprietor, 150 Albert Street, **Enoka Huia**, age about thirty-eight, height 5 ft. 10 in., labourer, Maori, medium build, copper complexion, black bushy hair, dark eyes; dressed in grey sports trousers, striped blazer of various colours, and light-brown overcoat. He called at complainant's garage and asked to be allowed a trial run with a used Chrysler car. He was permitted to take the car on condition that it be returned in one hour. He did not return the car, which was recovered at Kaukapakapa next day. Accused obtained £5 from Rowena Bethwaite, clerk, Hotel St. George, by means of a valueless cheque for that amount on the Bank of New Zealand, Wellington, dated 3rd March, 1937. **Morgan** had an account at the bank mentioned, but at the time he issued the cheque he knew that there were not sufficient funds to meet it.
