She may be identical with **Woman** (name unknown), referred to in Police Gazette, 1936, page 455: A silver-plated cruet dish; a silver-plated cake dish; three pairs of ladies' shoes; a cotton figured frock; a floral linen frock; an ensemble frock of satin-backed crepe material of navy colour, and marked "Made in Vienna"; a white crepe blouse; two striped silk blouses; a ladies' black straw hat trimmed with lilies; a ladies' navy toque hat; Nu-Venus corsets; Modaire brassiere; a three-piece laddaloe celanese set—slip, scanties, and vest of peach colour; a ladies' wool suit; a shirt; a ladies' suit; two ladies' ties; a singlet; two pairs of trunks; three bottles of lotion; powder; perfume; a manicure set on stand; a five-piece pink toilet-set; three pairs of hose; two pairs of ladies' gloves; three ladies' handbags; two pairs of scissors; a set of curlers; and a pair of wavers: total value, £43. Identification dopbtful. **No warrant.**
