At a recent trial, in the City of Brotherly Love, he produced a motive power equal to a pressure of 7,000lbs. to the square inch. He asserts that no chemical of any kind is used, and that electricity has nothing to do with his invention. The water, which is placed in a pear-shaped cylinder, was tested both before and after the experiment and found unchanged. It is supposed that the new power is produced by the decomposition of the water, by contact with the machine. Of course there is a great deal of mystery about the affair; nevertheless, several wealthy men have placed their money on the affair, and it is now patented. The inventor claims that by attaching his machine to an ordinary engine he can drive a train from New York to 'Frisco " on time" without any expenditure of power, save that generated in his machine by the two gallons of water. gallons of water.
