CONFERENCE OF BISHOPS.



ADVANTAGE was taken of the presence in Auckland of Archbishop REDWOOD and Bishop GRIMES on their return trip from the South Sea Islands to hold a conference of the New Zealand Bishops. The meeting took place on Saturday, August 4th, in the palatial residence of Bishop LUCK. Catholics throughout the Colony will unite with the assembled prelates in the expression of regret at the absence of the wise councils of the venerable Bishop of Dunedin. Dr MORAN was, however, represented by the Very Rev Dr EGAN, O.S.B., pastor of St Benedict's, Newton. We learn from our special correspondent, whom we asked to wire an account of the meeting, that the following resolution was carried unanimously:—"That in view of the deplorable fact that a large proportion of the Catholic children attending the non-Catholic schools in the Colony practically lose their faith, the Bishops of New Zealand again inculcate the grave duty incumbent on Catholic parents of sending their children to the Catholic schools, and warn them that the sending of their
