DR. DUHIG APPOINTED COADJUTOR-ARCHBISHOP

His Grace Archbishop Dunne on April 24 received an official communication from Rome (says the Catholic Advocate) stating that Dr. Duhig, Bishop of Rockhampton, has been selected as Coadjutor-Archbishop of the archdiocese with the right of succession to the Archiepiscopal See of Brisbane. The news comes as no surprise, indeed it has always been anticipated, and the premature announcements which have appeared from time to time have been based on the very strong probability amounting almost to a certainty that the youthful Bishop of Rockhampton, who has performed so many duties in the outlying portions of the archdiocese for some time, would receive first choice.

The people of the archdiocese have been brought into such close touch with the Coadjutor Archbishop, both in the capacity of priest and prelate that they will welcome his return permanently to their midst. Many there are who knew him in his youthful days in this city, long before he entered Holy Orders, and they will most heartily congratulate him on the fresh significant honor which has been conferred upon him.

Actually Dr. Duhig is not an Australian, but virtually he is, as he was only a very small boy when he arrived in Queensland, and it was here that his character was firmly moulded, and his education received, and it was here that his happy vocation came to him. His native place is County Limerick, which also gave to Australia Dr. Corbett, the venerable and eloquent Bishop of Sale, In Victoria. He is a native of Dromcolloher, in the extreme South of Limerick, just over the Cork boundary. After coming to Queensland he received the ground-work of an excellent education from the Christian Brothers, and he is one of their most distinguished past pupils.

He left school when comparatively young and he entered the commercial world. It was however, soon evident that the young man's bent was not a worldly life. The good example and teachings of the Christian Brothers had made a firm impression on him and

The good example and teachings of the Christian Brothers had made a firm impression on him, and acting on the advice of Archbishop Dunne he left Queensland at the age of 19 years with the intention of studying for the priesthood. He reached Rome, and entered the famous Irish College there, and on September 19, 1896, he was ordained. Then he was only 25 years of age, but little he or his friends thought that in less than sixteen years he would be Archbishop in an important diocese. Father Duhig arrived in Brisbane from the old world in June, 1897. Eight years later he was selected as Bishop of Rockhampton in succession to Bishop Higgins, who had been translated to Ballarat. On Sunday, December 10, 1905, in St. Joseph's Cathedral, Rockhampton, he was consecrated, and as he then was only 34 years of age, he was believed to be the youngest Bishop in the British Empire. To-day he is the youngest Archbishop in the Empire.
