

# WAIRARAPA HIGH SCHOOL - - MASTERTON.

PRINCIPAL ELEVATION.

The fine building illustrated above has been erected at Masterton to meet the rapidly growing demand for secondary education in the Wairarapa. The west elevation shown has a total length of 280 feet. It is isometrical, and one portion contains two stories, including the chemistry and physics laboratories and demonstration rooms. A wing running at right angles towards the east contains four large classrooms. The whole building is provided with means of easy communication by corridors at the rear. The building is constructed of red brick, with natural slate roofs. Its cost, including shelter sheds, boundary walls and gates, and furniture for laboratories and classrooms, is £16,500. Owing to the architect's departure for Sydney before the completion of the contract, Mr. Wm. M. Page, F.N.Z.I.A., took charge of the final stages of the work.
