Destiny The fabulous singer is once again produced by Arif Mardin and performs with Phil Collins on Watching the World', Scritti Politti on 'Love of a Lifetime' and throws in some rap on 'Earth to Mickey'. As dynamic as 'I Feel For You'l



SISTER SLEDGE **Greatest Hits**

At last, the fabulous Sister Sledge singles on one LP – from 'Frankie' way back to Chic produced gems 'Lost in Music' and We Are Family' both in remix/extended form for the first time in NZ.



COMIC RELIEF Utterly, Utterly, Live

THE FIXX WALKABOUT

Once again Rupert Hine produces another fine Fixx album with those quirky Fixx compositions and the captivating lyrics Cy Curnin. One of Britain's finest bands – 'Walkabout' is ample proof.

DWIGHT YOAKAM Guitars, Cadillacs etc

The new name in country music is DWIGHT YOAKAM! After a hot indie record and opening for the Blasters and Los Lobos, this Kentucky born singer/songwriter is "reclaiming territory for country music" with his "revitalised version of honky tonk"

LIMITED WARRANTY

A Minneapolis based band who travelled to England to record this debut album with Producer Brian Tench (OMD, Kate Bush). An album of brilliant melodic pop/rock.

NU SHOOZ POOLSIDE

Oregon sextet who have succeeded in dance, R&B and pop charts with infectious funky hit 'I Can't Wait'. This dance-happy blend of modern pop and R&B will set your toes tappin' inside your shooz.

SCREAMING BLUE MESSIAHS **GUN-SHY**

More dynamic guitar-based R&B from the pen of guitarist/vocalist Bill Carter with fellow Englishmen Chris Thompson (bass) and Kenny Harris (drums). If you like guitar rock'n'roll, don't miss it.
