C.K. Chaka and an all-star cast get funky here with Miles Davis (trumpet & vocals) on Prince's 'Sticky Wicked', Marcus Miller on 'I'll Be Around', Chris Jasper (ex Isley) producing 'Make It Last', Chaka's Rufus cohorts guest and there's a cookin' version of Stevie's 'Signed Sealed Delivered'.



OFRAHAZA Shaday

This Israeli superstar's voice was first heard in the USA as a sample on Eric B & Rakim's hip-hop classic 'Paid In Full', but she has recorded 20 albums in Israel. Her voice is wide-ranging and crystalline. A unique talent.



ROCK CITY ANGELS Young Man's Blues

TANITA TIKARAM Ancient Heart An 18 year old new signing to WEA


