WHITE LION
Big Game
It's two years since rockers White Lion released debut LP *Pride* with two USA Top 10 singles 'Wait' and 'When the Children Cry'. Check out first single 'Little Fighter' about the Rainbow Warrior, the guitar-laden 'Dirty Woman' and the speed boogie of 'Let's Go Crazy'.



JENNY MORRIS
Shiver
A bold new album from expatriate New Zealander who now lives in Sydney. The first hit single is 'Saved Me' from this Andrew Farris (INXS) produced album. Jenny has written some poignant and personal lyrics ('Little Little', 'Aotearoa'). An important album.



DON HENLEY
The End of the Innocence
Following his first multi-platinum LP for Geffen Records (featured hit 'Boys of Summer'), the former Eagles man, Don Henley, is back with a great album, aided by a crazy collection of guests from W.Axl Rose to Melissa Etheridge. A fine album.



MARIA MCKEE
Maria McKee
The brilliant singer who fronted Lone Justice has now gone solo and recorded this superb LP with Mitchell Froom (Crowded House, Elvis Costello). You must take the time to listen to her touching melodies, emotional lyrics and soaring voice. First single is the haunting ballad 'To Miss Someone'.




TRANSVISION VAMP
Velveten
Wendy James, Nick Christian Sayer, Tex Axile and Dave Parsons are back with another hit album and a new hit single 'The Only One'. Other great tracks are 'Baby I Don't Care', 'Landslide of Love' and 'Bad Valentine'.




CHER
Heart of Stone
Once again Cher has worked with some of rock's finest songwriters and producers — including Desmond Child, Peter Asher and Michael Bolton. Hot tracks include 'Love on a Rooftop', 'Emotional Fire' and 'Just Like Jesse James'.



MAVIS STAPLES
Time Waits For No One
This is the first album by Mavis Staples for Prince's Paisley Park label. Mavis was the lead vocalist in the Staple Singers who recorded the original versions of 'I'll Take You There' (Ruby Turner) and 'Respect Yourself'. Prince introduces Mavis to the new funk — check out 'Train', 'I Guess I'm Crazy' and 'Jaguar'.




STEVE REICH
Kronos Quartet, Pat Metheny
On this album Steve Reich works with the KRONOS Quartet on 'Different Trains' and Pat Metheny playing 11 electric guitars and two electric basses on 'Electric Counterpoint'. Critics rave; "entirely new in its voice-instrument fusions" — "the most humane use of sampling technology."



WAYLON JENNINGS
New Classic Waylon
A best of from Waylon's last four albums for MCA — *Hangin' Tough*, *Full Circle*, *A Man Called Hoss* and *Will the Wolf Survive*. Truly classic tracks proving that though Waylon's perspective is mature, his spirit remains unbroken.



NITTY GRITTY DIRT BAND
Will the Circle Be Unbroken Vol.2
Once again the band play with a who's who of country and rock on four sides of classics — Chris Hillman, Johnny Cash, Roger McGuinn, Ricky Scaggs, Chet Atkins, John Hiatt, Emmylou Harris etc.



LEAN ON ME
Original Movie Soundtrack
A soundtrack that has the gospel feel of the title track (performed by Thelma Houston & the Winans) right beside Guns N'Roses modern classic 'Welcome to the Jungle'. Also includes great funk / rap from TKA, Roxanne Shante, Big Daddy Kane, Force MDs and Stetsasonic.



GUY
Guy
These guys are one of the hottest new sounds in dance music. The main man is ace producer Teddy Riley and dance club hits of this album so far are — 'Groove Me', 'Teddy's Jam', 'Spend the Night' and 'I Like'. You love it!




STACEY Q
Nights Like This
The third album from Stacey Q. This album has her trademark high tech, pop / dance fare like 'Give You All My Love' and the title track, but there's new explorations, a duet with ex Eagle Timothy B.Schmidt on 'Heartbeat' and a sublime ballad 'The Edge of Love'.



NIKKI
Nikki
A young 21 year old guy from Chicago who knows his funky licks — he has worked with the Deele, Ohio Players and Midnight Starr. He wrote and produced all the tracks on his debut LP — he can play mean electric guitar on 'Wild Boys' and supple acoustic guitar on 'Notice Me'. Watch out for Nikkil!



RAINBOW WARRIORS
Greenpeace Double Album
Proceeds from the sales of this amazing 27 track collection (30 on CD & tape) of contemporary music goes to the work of Greenpeace to promote environmental issues. Artists appearing include U2, Sting, R.E.M., INXS, Eurythmics, Simple Minds, Sade, Dire Straits, Lou Reed etc.




MARSHALL CRENSHAW
Good Evening
Here Crenshaw works with Joe Jackson's collaborator David Kershenbaum — and it's hot. Prime cuts include juicy rocker 'You Should've Been There', John Hiatt's 'Someplace Where Love Can't Find Me' and killer covers Richard Thompson's 'Valerie', Isley Brothers' 'Live It Up' and Bobby Fuller's 'Let Her Dance'.




CHRIS ISAAK
Heart Shaped World
This is the third LP from the North California-based performer who recently did a cameo in *Married to the Mob*. The album was recorded with Chris' regular band and a few studio aces. Key cuts are 'Don't Make Me Dream about You', 'Wicked Game' and 'In the Heat of the Jungle'.



ADRIAN BELEW
Mr. Music Head
One of the most talked about guitarists of the '80s, Belew first discovered by Frank Zappa in the late 70s and has recorded or toured with Bowie, Talking Heads, King Crimson and Laurie Anderson. This is his fourth solo LP, his first for Atlantic records — innovative, quirky and sonically mesmerizing and his finest work to date.



TRIUMPH
Classics
At last a collection of the finest tracks by supreme metallers Triumph — 'Fight the Good Fight', 'Spellbound', 'Rock N'Roll Machine', 'Follow Your Heart' and 'Tears in the Rain'.



LONDON BOYS
12 Commandments of Dance
The London Boys are Dennis Fuller and Edem Ephraim and here they deliver a great album of new dance music. England swings! Check out 'London Nights', 'Requiem' and 'My Love'.



THE CALL
Let the Day Begin
Another excellent album from the Call — Michael Been, Tom Ferrier, Scott Musick and Jim Goodwin. Actor Harry Dean Stanton is guest harmonica player on 'For Love' — otherwise the Call are self-sufficient. Great rock n' roll!




KON KAN
Move to Move
The guys that have given you the hit single 'I Beg Your Pardon' and hot new single 'Harry Houdini' have a whole album of fabulous tunes — such as 'Glue and Fire', 'Puss N' Boots', 'These Boots Are Made For Walking'. Massive pop music — hearing is believing!



THE KARATE KID PART 3
Original Movie Soundtrack
This hit film includes the Pointer Sisters' remake of the 60s hit 'Summer in the City' (by the Lovin' Spoonful), a rocker by Winger, two tracks by Glenn Medeiros, plus tracks by the Boys Club and the key song 'Listen to Your Heart' by the Little River Band.



LILLIAN AXE
Love 'WAR
A hot and heavy guitar band with a great new album produced by Tony Platt. Vanity does a guest "rap" on 'My Number' and other raunchy tracks include 'All's Fair in Love and War', 'She Likes It On Top' and 'Down On You'. Heavy!



WOODSTOCK 2
Jimi Hendrix etc
This second volume from the infamous 1969 festival movie has 17 minutes of Hendrix (3 tracks), Jefferson Airplane, Joan Baez, Mountain, Crosby Stills Nash & Young, Paul Butterfield Blues Band, Melanie and Canned Heat. Issued on CD and tape only.



SMASHED GLADYS
Social Intercourse
The raunchiest new rockers on the block, fronted by one very tough lady. Hot tracks include 'Lick it into Shape', '7 goin' On Crazy', 'Play Dirty', 'Hard to Swallow' and 'Legs Up'. They call it *Social Intercourse*.
