It also features They Were Expendable with a live recording of 'Stuck and Starved at Mainstreet' plus Bottletops and Toerag.

The latter two are also issuing a 7" EP featuring additional songs.

AEB are all go with their cassette release of the LP by Los Angeles bands Millions of Dead The release has been financed by private loan and the successful Buck A Head special at the Gladstone on Labour Day. The LP will be available by mail order by the end of the year. Next release will be an LP by Wellington's Mole Manne, recorded at Tandem. 


