# LET LOVE RULE

On the cusp of the '90s comes Lenny Kravitz, a new artist' with a remarkable gift. Kravitz, 24, has come out of nowhere to create a milestone debut album, the selfwritten, self-produced and largely self-performed "LET LOVE RULE". Those who have heard him compare the multi-talented young artist to many people, while Kravitz cites Curtis Mayfield, Jimi Hendrix, Bob Marley and John Lennon's solo work as primary influence.

"I'm looking for a certain sound...and as far as I'm concerned 'state of the art' was in 1967," Lenny Kravitz "LET LOVE RULE" could well have been merely an exercise in retro passiche, a Raby Roomer Trivial Pursuit

exercise in retro pastiche, a Baby Boomer Trivial Pursuit spot-the-reference album which soon bores. But it doesn't get bogged down in cute period detail — the sound has the muscularity of The Beatles at their bluesiest such as on Don't Let Me Down — and his righteous yet immensely catchy songs are the reason why Lenny Kravitz demands your attention."

PANDORA'S BOX — Original Sin

examine SIN, in all its glory, by way of huge, barrel-thumping ballads, sampled Verdi, backing vocals arranged by Todd Rundgren, sensitive piano and opera-style narrative links.

Four female lead vocalists steer Steinman's grand and opulent vehicle into a parking space somewhere between straight FM Rock and 'War Of The Worlds'.

Steinman has created a monster. This is as unsurprising as the fact that Ken Russell has directed the promos. After all, Steinman also created 'Bat Out Of Hell', 'Total Eclipse Of The Heart' and the *nouveau* Sisters Of Mercy. But whether the current poncy old Free Western World is ready for 'Original Sins' wuthering heights and measurements, God only knows. In fact, if God made an LP it would probably

sound a lot like this . . .
