Fox / James Woods** comedy *The Hard Way*... **David Bowie** plays a "charming, compulsive liar and gambler" in *The Linguine Incident* with **Rosanna Arquette**... **A Tribe Called Quest** have a very appropriate title for their new live video, it's called *The Art of Moving Butts in Europe*... with the **Time** LP *Pandemonium* burnin' up turntables, singer **Morris** ("Fishnet stockings") **Day** will star as a hair stylist **Lamarr** in TV sitcom *New Attitude*... **Spinal Tap** bassist **Harry Shearer** has recorded a rap piss-take of moral crusaders as the **Sheriff of Yahoo County**. 
It wasn't until much later, around midnight, when he pulled up a chair at a table full of models, that he finally removed his shades. Dave might have included a cautionary song on his new album called 'Fashion Bomb' about how models on the rock scene risk becoming "terminally fucked up cases" but when it comes to conversation he knows where to turn as readily as the next man.

He's no slouch himself when it comes to talking. Speaking with a slight Sunderland slur (due in part to the Kamikaze cocktails consumed the night before: BMG likes to show its artists a good time) Dave talked about the philosophy behind his new group, the Spiritual Cowboys, how "we're on the brink of a spiritual


The world's new budget mixer designed by DISCO MIX CLUB for DJs, the official mixer of the 1991 World DJ Championships.
