**ERIC CLAPTON** 24 Nights

A double live album culled from a series of concerts at London's Royal Albert Hall, February. Clapton works here in four formats — his regular 4-piece, a blues all star ensemble, a 9-piece band and then an orchestra. Guests include Phil Collins, Robert Cray, Buddy Guy, Jimmy Vaughan and Albert Collins.



PAUL SIMON Born at the Right Time (Best
