Motor City Magic (ABC / Festival Video) This series of 30min compilations from the USA *Shindig* show was intelligently collated by USA collector label Rhino. *Shindig* was the USA equivalent to England's *Ready Steady Go* and screened in NZ in the 60s, influencing the local productions *Let's Go* and *C'mon*.

The *Soul* compile has some rare performances, Tina Turner and Marvin Gaye doing a 'Money / I'll Be Daggone' medley, lesser known Major Lance, Booker T & the MGs, Marvin Gaye, Joe Tex and two dynamic appearances by James Brown.

The *Jackie Wilson* tape is my fav, nine songs showing his phenomenal singing and moves. Great tracks are 'Baby Workout', 'No Pity (In the Naked City)' and 'Whole Lot of Shakin' Going On' with Jerry Lee Lewis.

Groovy Gals has such rarities as the Toys, Fontella Bass, Shangri-Las, Jackie De Shannon, Blossoms, Petula Clark and Aretha Franklin doing the R&R 'Shoop Shoop Song'.

Motor City Magic is a collection of gems by artists from the Motown label — Jnr Walker, Temptations, Martha & the Vandellas, Mary Wells, Four Tops, Supremes and Smokey Robinson and the Miracles.

Frat Party has the Kingsmen murdering 'Louie Louie' live, the Hondells doing 'Little Honda' sitting on Hondas with go-go dancers bouncing

on each backseat. Tackyl There's also the McCoys, Zsa Zsa Gabor, Isley Brothers doing 'Shout' and Jerry Lee Lewis powering through 'Great Balls of Fire'. Delightful rarity here is Olympics doing 'Good Lovin' before the Rascals made it a mega-hit.

Righteous Brothers are fab on 'You've Lost That Lavin' Feelin'' and they do great Roy Charles on some of their own hits and on Charles' 'Night Time is the Right Time'. They looked like geeks but those guys sure could sing.

Shindig was sponsored by a milk company and kinky milk adverts screen on each video — go-go dancers looking lusty as they drink their glasses of milk, lick their lips and then go back to dancing with teen idol Bobby Sherman. Wow! *I dig Shindig!*

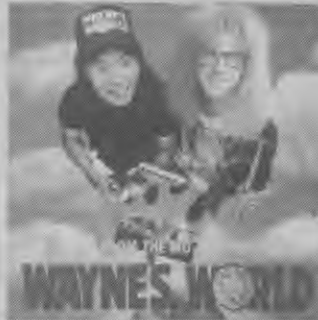
ERIC CLAPTON

IAN McCULLOCH
Mysterio
 The second solo release from the former mainman for Echo & the Bunnymen. Ten anthemic new originals plus his sparkling cover of Leonard Cohen's 'Lover Lover Lover'. Anton Corbijn (U2 Depeche Mode) is shooting a video for this song. Try 'Honeydrip', 'Magical World'.



DAVID BYRNE
Uh-Oh
 The all-around Renaissance man of Talking Heads is back with his first solo album since 1989's 'Rei Momo'. Twelve new songs that are both playful & profound. Although the Latin vibe is still in effect here, the overall feel is accessible and not far removed from mid 80s Talking Heads. Byrne at his best.

Heavy Rock Movie Soundtrack
 Best of modern and classic rock from Queen (Bo Rhapsody), Red Hot Chili Peppers (Sikamikanica), Jimi Hendrix (Foxy Lady), Gary Wright (Dream Weaver) — and tracks by Bulletboys, Eric Clapton, Alice Cooper, Cinderella, Black Sabbath and Rhina Bucket.



CHIC
Chic-ism
 The 70s funk team are back. Nile Rodgers and Bernard Edwards return to their 'Le Freak' and 'Good Times' grooves of classic Chic. Great grooves, check out first single 'Chic Mystique'. 'Your Love' rapper Princess on 'Something You Can Feel'.



PANTERA
Vulgar Display of Power
 These hardcore rockers follow up their *Cowboys From Hell* album with more angry tattoo rock such as 'Be Demons Be Driven', 'Mouth for War' and 'Fucking Hostile'. Power metal music from the hard gigging, hard rockin' crew from Hell. Produced by Terry Date (Soundgarden, Mother Love Bone).



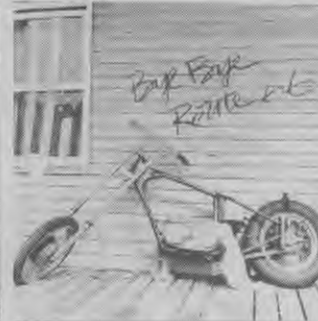
KISS OF THE GYPSY
Kiss of the Gypsy
 Great rockers from Blackpool, in Britain' Northwest produced by former Jethro Tull drummer Barriemore Barlow. 'Where has a band this good been hiding?' says *Raw* mag. *Kerrang!* says, 'crunching good riffs... cut through with fiery, taut guitar solos, excellent bluesy vocalist and classy songs.'



GERALD LEVERT
Private Line
 Gerald Levert comes from the famous Philadelphia soul family, his father is Eddie Levert of the O'Jays and Gerald records as part of the hitmaking trio Levert. Father and son duet on 'Baby Hold To Me'. Hot tracks include 'School Me', 'Private Line' and 'I Wanna Be Bad'.



THE NEIGHBOURHOODS
The Neighbourhoods
 This dynamic rock trio are produced by Brad Whitford of Aerosmith, who also guests on guitar, keyboards and backing vocals. The 'Hoods' are the brilliant songwriter David Minehan (vocals guitar), Lee Harrington (bass) and Carl Coletti (drums). Great tracks include 'Roxanne' and 'Pure & Easy'.



DEVONSQUARE
Bye Bye Route 66
 After two indie albums and a critically acclaimed Atlantic debut *Walking On Ice*, this trio return with a rockier sound than their prior release and Stephen Stills guesting on guitar for 'Straightaway'. Experience their finely-crafted songwriting and alluring three-part harmonies.
