

Green Stone mace
flat & sharp at the edges
hung up to secure the use of iron to the tourist.



LONG CLUB or MACE
from here, this is flat & sharp on the edges



Engraved on each side of the medal found at Dusky Bay 1825.



Implement for digging
Baracoola hook

1. 2. spears, with knotholes cut in them answering the purposes of a bodder.
