Acquisitions of oral history sound recordings will be listed selectively in the *Turnbull Library Record* at two-yearly intervals. The principal finding aid for oral history is a database on the KIWINET system. The majority of recent accessions can be searched by using the database. For items marked 'Restricted', or not notified as being searchable on the KIWINET Oral History Database, the Library would prefer advance notification from intending researchers, preferably with a likely date.
