

ELSE, BARBARA, 1947–. *Papers, 1990–2005*. 1.25 m.

Electronic and hardcopy drafts of literary works by Else. Correspondence with publishers and other writers. PURCHASE.

GORRIE, MINNIE, fl. 1877–1882. *Fiji diary, 1877–1882*. 1 volume.

A diary recording events in colonial Fiji, 1877–1882, by the daughter of the Chief Justice of Fiji. PURCHASE.

JACKSON, ANN FLETCHER, 1833–1903. *Diaries, 1860–1900*. 22 cm.
