ARTIST UNKNOWN. [*Portrait of Te Ngarara Tenawa, Chief of the Ngāti Awa, Whakatane, ca 1825*]. Oil on canvas. A head and shoulders profile portrait of the chief who attacked and captured the Brig *Haweis* off Whakatane in 1823. He is seen brandishing a mere in a threatening way. PURCHASE.

ABBOT, EDWARD IMMYNS, d.1849. [*A high country surveyor's camp in bleak conditions, Otago, ca 1847*]. Watercolour. Two surveyors (and their dog) attempting to boil their billy in wind and rain. Abbot, one of the first Otago surveyors, worked in the Taieri area until his premature death. PURCHASE.
