Twelve interviews by Anna Soutar with people engaged in the behind-the-scenes working of a movie theatre over the last 50 years. The project received an Award in Oral History.

*Interview with Sir Robert Rex, 1976.*

Interview by Tony Johns with the Premier of Niue from self-government in 1974 until his death in 1992. This extended interview covers the period from his childhood to the 1960s.

*Interviews with Wiremu Kerekere and Henare Te Ua, 1999-2000.*

Life history interviews by Libby Hakaraia with these two well known Māori broadcasters. The project received an Award in Oral History.

*Mussel farming oral history project, 1999-2000.*

Thirty three interviews by Carol Dawber, commissioned by the Mussel Farming Association, recording people associated with the industry in its early days in the Marlborough Sounds in the 1970s and 1980s.

*Ocean Beach bach community oral history project, 1997-2000.*

Twelve interviews by Sunita Singh with bach residents of this south Wairarapa coastal community, many of whom have occupied their baches since the 1950s. The project received an Award in Oral History

*Past champions oral history project, 1997-2000.*

Eighteen interviews commissioned by the Shear History Trust, with Golden Shears champions since 1961 when the sheep shearing competition began. The project received an Award in Oral History.
